

2010 Census Jobs Available

The U.S. Census Bureau is recruiting temporary, part-time census takers for the 2010 Census. These short term jobs offer good pay (\$15.25 per hour), flexible hours (5-40 hours per week), paid training, and reimbursement for authorized work-related expenses, such as mileage incurred while conducting census work. And census takers work close to home in their own communities.

Census taker jobs are excellent for people who want to work part-time, those who are between jobs, students 18 years or older, or just about anyone who wants to earn extra money while performing an important service for their community.

Recruiters are hosting a 30-minute employment exam in many local communities, with many dates and times available.
