The 2007 F350 pick up v box spreader needed some parts ordered to make the chain run they will be in Thursday. The vac-all has been completely gone over and is ready for spring. Next week we are bringing in the motor grader and the tiger mower to be gone over so they are ready for when the weather breaks.
