Harlan Shober – Chairman called this public hearing to order at 6:49 p.m. (due to a Conditional Use Hearing held earlier).

The purpose of this hearing is to take public comment on a proposed Sidewalk Ordinance.

ATTENDANCE:

Attending this evenings hearing were Supervisors Harlan G. Shober, Jr., A. William Kiehl and Richard W. Metzler. Additionally in attendance were James Liekar-Solicitor; Samuel R. Stockton-Township Manager; Daniel Slagle-Township Engineer; Harold Ivery, Jr.-Zoning/Planning Officer and Wendy Williams-Recording Secretary.

Mr. Liekar: “When the Township entered into agreement with PENNDOT on the road project in Meadow Lands the Township is required to adopt an ordinance on to make sure every sidewalk in the Township is maintained whenever it is torn up or snow is removed requiring the property owner or tenant to clean and maintain their sidewalk. If there is a sidewalk in front of your property and it needs repaired you have to replace it. You cannot block it from traffic.
