A motion was made by Mr. Marcischak and seconded by Mr. Kiehl to authorize the installation of a stop sign, as recommended by the Chief. Also authorize the Solicitor to prepare an ordinance. Motion carried.

Reviewed and commented on Volunteer Fire Department's grant application narrative.

The Army Corps of Engineers is in the process of closing the Route 18 Project Grant and a final accounting of the project costs has been prepared and submitted to the Township. Federal Funds in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 were provided for the Project design, construction and associated costs

The Township Engineer, Director of Public Works and I developed a list of roads for the 2012 Paving Project.

Conference call with the Township Engineer, Solicitor and Penn Vest to determine the settlement date for the Penn Vest Loan for the Midland Sewer Project.

Pubic Works Director – Edward Jeffries

Trucks – 1995 is at K&P – Oil pan and fuel tank is leaking. The 2004 Ford F550 has been inspected and ready.

Paved-Potholes - We have been patching backside of Brigich due to the heavy truck traffic last fall. We will be digging out the berm on Reed to make the road wider.

Storm Drains – We repaired 3 Storm drains on Orchard and East Country Barn.

Tree's – We have been cutting tree limbs that have fell last week.

Mowing – We have been on the 18 side country roads on the second cut.

8 Crossroads Road – There is a court hearing scheduled for July 16, 2012.

McMillen Welding has been sited and awaiting on the court date from the District Justice.

UCC Board of Appeals – Only one member was appointed. Names are to be provided and brought back to the Board.

The Township has had a request for Rezoning from David Jardini – This is to be tabled for the meeting of July 17, 2012.

Township Engineer – Daniel Slagle

Development Proposals

- 1. <u>Piatt Subdivision Plan</u> We met with the Developer's Engineer on 6/27/2012 to review plan concept and discuss PRD vs Subdivision Plan.
- 2. <u>Villas at Arden Mills PRD</u> We have reviewed/responded to advisory meeting minutes by the Developer on May 31, 2012 regarding the PC's comments/conditions for approval of the updated PRD for Phases IV, V and VI.

<u>Capital Improvement Projects</u>

- 1. Midland Sewer Project We are updating the construction drawings, resolving utility conflicts, revising sewer profiles and preparing the required PaDOT Highway Occupancy Permit Application. The most competitive window to bid large sewer projects are January/February 2013 with construction to start in April 2013.
- 2. <u>Midland Sewer R/W</u> We are plotting/assembling the property data, developing customer database and preparing R/W Exhibits. A Townhall meeting will be scheduled to update the Township residents and acquire the required R/W's in July/August 2012.
- 3. <u>PennVEST Financing</u> We participated in a conference call with PennVEST regarding project status/closing with the Solicitor/Manager.

4. <u>Chartiers Township Community Center</u> – We updated the Site Plan based on our survey data and are coordinating a wetland study in preparation of finalizing the Site Plan. We transmitted the preliminary Site Plan with building footprint to Hayes Design Group in preparation of the subsurface borings.

On-Going Developer Projects

1. Chartiers Industrial Park Site Plan PH I/II – Construction started 8/15/11. The project restarted on 3/22/2012. We are currently providing Construction Surveillance. We are designing the off-site sewer to merge with their sewer. A R/W from Ellis Asphalt is required to extend the sewer across their property.

On-Going Township Projects

- 1. <u>2012 Paving Project</u> We met with the Manager to finalize the 2012 road list in preparation of preparing the plans/specs.
- 2. <u>2012 Sewer Rehabilitation Project</u> We reviewed the Video and compiled the necessary data to prepare the plans and spec. for an August 14 2012 bid.

A motion was made by Mr. Marcischak and seconded by Mr. Kiehl to approve a proposed agreement with 12 Cottages, LLC for 30 hours of Police Services on August 25, 2012. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Marcischak and seconded by Mr. Kiehl to set August 14, 2012 to adopt the Act 167 Storm Water Ordinance.

A motion was made by Mr. Marcichak and seconded by Mr. Kiehl to approve the 2012 Road Program with the following roads to be considered for resurfacing: Reed Ave., Cummins Ave. (from West Pike to Green Street) Regent Street and McGovern Road. Mr. Jeffries is to measure McGovern Road. The measurement is to be forwarded to the Engineer. Bids are to be opened on August 14, 2012. Motion carried.
