## CHARTIERS TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS BUDGET WORKSHOP & OTHER BUSINESS TUESDAY October 24, 2017 4:30 p.m.

A. William Kiehl-Chairman called the Budget Workshop to order, at 4:39 p.m. Tuesday, October 24, 2017.

## ATTENDANCE:

Attending the workshop were Supervisors John M. Marcischak, Glenn Alterio (arrived at 4:48 p.m.) and Mr. Kiehl. Also attending were Jodi L. Noble-Township Manager, Dan Deiseroth of Gateway Engineering and Bev Small-Recording Secretary.

Mrs. Noble highlighted information on the various Sewer Funds for review as follows:

1. MIDLAND SEWER DISTRICT FUND:

Mr. Deiseroth presented a Project Status Report from information gathered at a prior meeting with the Township Manager and Engineer addressing the shortfall in the annual debt service that were based on the number of customers projected with a smaller number actually tapped in and paying as well as the term of the PennVest Loan. He presented several alternatives with the two recommended for Board consideration being a refinancing alternative or a hybrid combination with other Chartiers Districts which would raise everyone's rate another \$3 in 2018 after the \$1.91 raise in 2017. We believe the former Engineer based calculations for the Debt Service on a 30 year period and PennVest is a 20 year period. The shortfall has been covered with a budgeting factor transfer of \$30,000 in 2017 and will likely need that in 2018 barring arrival at an alternate solution to cover the debt service. Minimal legal fees and restoration costs are still pending.

- ROUTE 18 SEWER DISTRICT FUND: Revenues are showing an increase; Expenditures generally relate to legal costs and the Canton agreement and outstanding balance portion.
- CHARTIERS SEWER FUND: Revenues are increasing; different software options are being investigated; budgeted amount for I & I in 2018 is included.
- 4. GENERAL FUND:

Discussion ensued centered on Earned Income Tax, Host Fees and options for reducing the deficit which will be addresses in an upcoming budget meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
