- 5. <u>Piatt Estates Offsite Sewer Line Dedication/Reimbursement Agreement</u> DEP require Sewage Planning of CHJA for taps; Township has application pay option of one fee of \$500.00 to proceed for tap-in permits
- 6. <u>CARES Act Funding Application and County Agreement</u> Mrs. Noble presented a listing of potentially qualifying purchases and installation by November 30, 2020. Mrs. Noble will have a Resolution prepared for action at the next meeting.
