## **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. A motion was made by Mr. Metzler and seconded by Mr. Marcischak to adopt Resolution R-12-2014 to establish the 2015 real estate tax rated of 9 mills for general purposes for Chartiers Township and other such tax rates as included therein as recommended by the Township Manager. All Supervisors voted yes. The motion was carried.

2. A motion was made by Mr. Metzler and seconded by Mr. Marcischak to adopt the2015 Final Budget and adopt Resolution R-13-2014accordingly as recommended by the Township Manager. All Supervisors voted yes. The motion was carried.

3. A motion was made by Mr. Metzler and seconded by Mr. Marcischak to award the bid for the 2014 winter material bid for up to 600 tons of Type IllA Anti-Skid to Thomas & Son Trucking of Bulger PA for the bid amount of \$17.99 per ton as recommended by the Township Manager and Director of Public Works and in accordance with the public bid opening of December 12, 2014. A motion was made by Mr. Metzler and seconded by Mr. Marcischak to authorize payment of invoices (General Fund: Check #29748-#29777: \$199,562.26; Sewer Fund: Check #2798-#2801: \$5,329.04; act 13 Impact Fee: Check #1053: \$11,800.80; Midland Sewer Fund: Check #1031: \$18,873.70; Light & Hydrant Fund: Check #1502: \$206.76; RT. 18 SLE Fund: Check #1201, 1020: \$1,644.00; Local Services Tax Fund Check #1466: \$435.50; Capital Reserve Fund: Check #1015: \$1,711.85; Total All Funds: \$241,508.49). - Fence next door (property Corner of W. Pike Street and Race Track Road) they have crashed so much of their equipment into the fence; the fence is bent down, tumbling over. They need to restore the fence.
- Retention and Detention Ponds need to be visited. Where people have thrown garbage and debris. If not cleaned by the property owner, the Township cites them through ordinance.
