Our day includes a guided tour of the Yoder property, where local guides lead us through Amish homes and a 120-year-old bank barn with animals on site, sharing insight into Amish history, beliefs, and lifestyle. Next, enjoy a memorable ride in an authentic Amish buggy, driven by a member of the Amish church. The ride travels about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile through the hay fields, and guests may even sit up front beside the driver.

We'll then head to Berlin Farmstead for a delicious hot buffet lunch, followed by stops at Heini's Cheese Chalet and Kauffman's Country Bakery.

In the afternoon, sit back and enjoy the variety show "Macho Mule" at Amish Country Theater. This variety show is packed with non-stop laughs and surprises. The show features fan-favorite comedian Lynyrd, the Amish comedy duo The Beachy Boys with their humorous parodies, and world-renowned ventriloquist Kevin Johnson (as seen on America's Got Talent, Late Night with David Letterman, and Disney Cruise Lines). With a mix of comedy, music, ventriloquism, and specialty acts, Macho Mule delivers fresh jokes and unforgettable fun.

Before heading home, we'll make one final stop at Walnut Creek Cheese & Market to stock up on goodies before returning to the Community Center.
