**RECYCLABLE ITEMS:** Paper, Food & Beverage Cans, Plastic jars-jugs & Tubs (narrow neck containers labeled #1 and #2), Flattened Cardboard and Paperboard. No Plastic Bags.

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# 2022 Observed Holidays

Waste Management observe the following holidays.

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

When Your Collection day falls on or after one of these holidays, your service will be delayed one day during that week only. Collection will not be delayed due to New Year's Day or Christmas Day in 2022







### 2022 Recycling Program



We are excited to announce the acceptance of plastic tubs in your curbside recycling program. Acceptable plastic tubs have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter. Plastic tub lids and food must be removed before the container can be recycled.

Waste Management is asking your community to help combat recycling contamination. For programs to be successful, all participants must make an effort to practice good recycling habits.

- No plastic bags of any kind will be accepted. Please place material loose in your recycling bin or cart.
- Make sure you are only recycling plastic bottles, jugs, jars and tubs. Acceptable plastic tubs
  have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter.
  Plastic tub lids and food must be removed before the container can be recycled. Any other
  plastic shape must go in the trash.
- · Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- · Shredded paper is not accepted.

**Recycling will be collected Monthly.** Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below together in your recycling cart or bin.
