

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that separate and sealed Bids will be received by the Chartiers Township on Friday, May 17, 2013 at the office of the Township, 2 Buccaneer Drive, Houston, PA 15342 until 12:00 P.M. The Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time for the following work:

### MIDLAND SANITARY SEWER PROJECT CONTRACT NUMBER 4-12

The project consists of the construction of approximately 973 linear feet of 18" PVC, 175 linear feet of 18" C-900, 515 linear feet of 16" DIP, 6,235 linear feet of 15" PVC, 1,616 linear feet of 10" PVC, 12,926 linear feet of 8" PVC, 923 linear feet of 8" DIP, and 1,050 linear feet of 6" PVC sanitary sewer including 114 manholes, five State road borings, six stream crossings, and 275 wyes over public and private easements within the Township of Chartiers as indicated on the Drawings together with all excavation; environmental control measures; and restoration of all disturbed areas.

The contract documents and proposal forms may be examined and sets of drawings, specification and contract documents may be obtained at the office of Nichols & Slagle Engineering, Inc., 333 Rouser Road, Airport Office Park, Fourth Floor, Suite 600, Moon Township, Pennsylvania 15108, upon a non-refundable fee of \$100.00 for each set of documents.

A Bid Security comprised of a certified check or bid bond drawn to the order of the Chartiers Township executed by the bidder and a surety company satisfactory to the Township, in an amount equal to not less than ten percent of the total amount of the Bid must be submitted with the proposal. All proposals shall be submitted in accordance with the INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS, BID SUBMISSION.

This project will be partially funded by the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority under the Clean Water Revolving Fund. Compliance shall be required with the Davis Bacon Wage Rate made by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry for this project.

Except as otherwise provided by law, no Bidder may withdraw his Bid within 120 days after the actual date of the Bid Opening.

The Chartiers Township hereby reserves the right, which is understood and agreed to by all Bidders, to reject any or all Bids submitted; and also reserves the right to waive any informality in bids received, but any contract work awarded will be to the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder.
