We'll begin our day heading north to Drake Well Museum and Park, where we'll explore the birthplace of the petroleum industry. Through orientation films, exhibits, historic buildings, and oil field machinery, the museum tells the story of how Pennsylvania's oil industry began and grew into a global enterprise. Visitors will enjoy highlights such as a replica of Drake's original engine house built around the National Historic Landmark well, an operating oil lease, a standard drilling rig, and over 12,000 square feet of indoor exhibits on the museum's scenic 240-acre site.



Next, we'll experience the beauty of fall aboard a 90-minute scenic train ride on the Oil Creek & Titusville Railroad. Traveling at a relaxed pace of about 12 mph, you'll have plenty of time to enjoy the autumn scenery and capture photos of the colorful landscape.



After the train ride, we'll board the motorcoach and head to Franklin, PA for an afternoon at their annual Applefest. What began as a small pie contest in 1983 has grown into a popular three-day event featuring free entertainment, more than 300 arts, crafts, and food vendors, and a charming Victorian downtown atmosphere. This stop will include self-pay lunch and free time to explore the festival.
